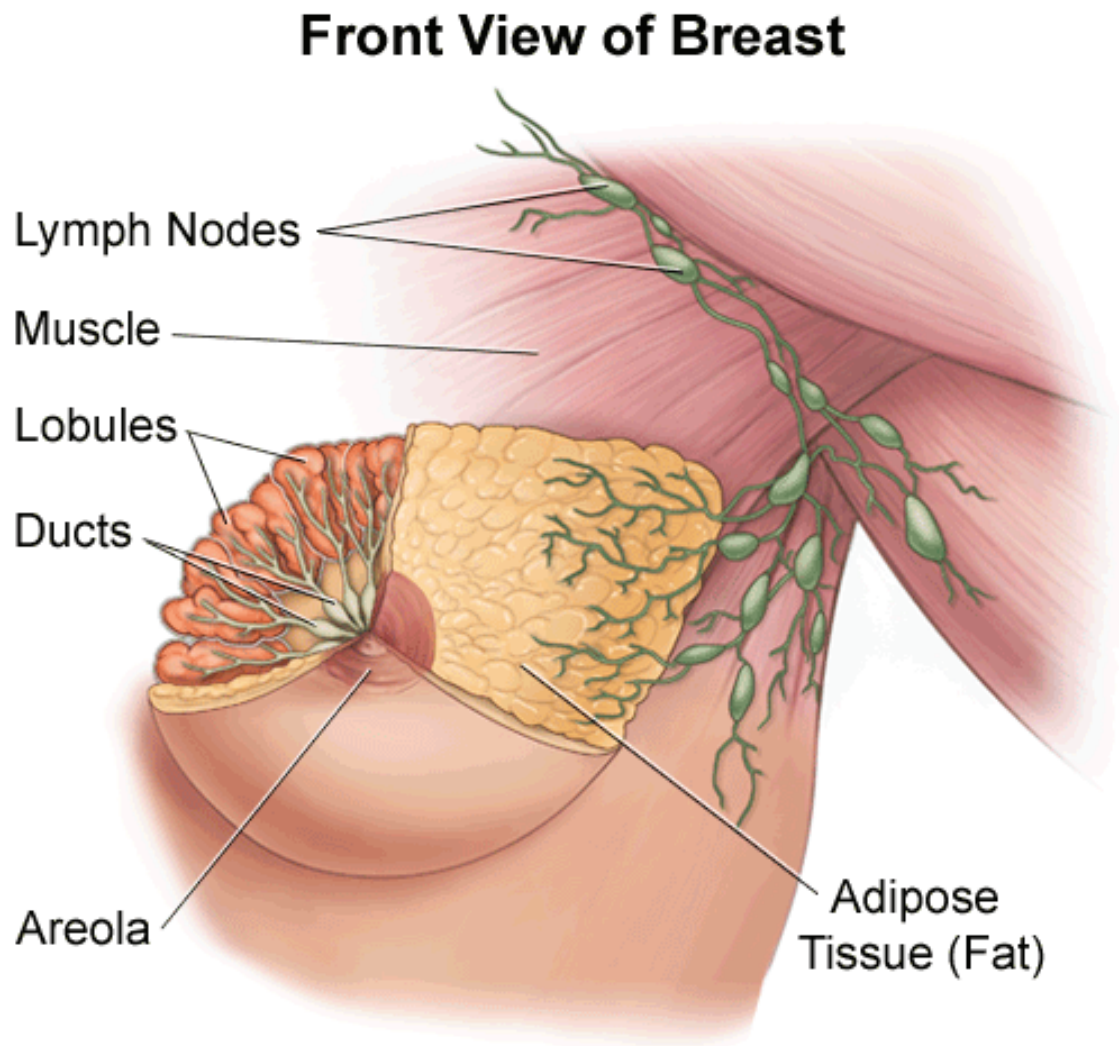


Breast Lumps



- Breast lumps are the commonest presenting symptom.
- The majority of breast lumps are benign (or non-cancerous). These include:
 - Fibroadenoma
 - Fibrocystic changes
 - Cyst
 - Abscess
 - Milk cyst
 - Lipoma
- Approximately 10% of breast lumps are malignant (or cancerous).
- Signs of a breast tumour include a painless breast lump, bloody nipple discharge, persistent rash around the nipple and lumps around the armpit.
